Hugged by rolling hills, this contemporary retreat has been designed to provide shelter from the warm, Mediterranean rays and the business of life far beyond. Organic, earthy textures are accompanied by state-of-the-art comforts including a cinema and football pitch.

Ibican style gets a Californian accent in this single-storey villa. Behind its modernist facade, the poured concrete, bespoke Sabina-wood cladding and designer furnishings of the open-plan living area set a slick note for the rest of the home. It's a naturally bright, laid-back space, designed for drifting between the kitchen, formal dining area and low-slung sofas.

Wall-to-wall windows connect you to the valley, whether you're kicking back by the TV, soaking in a freestanding tub or watching sunrise over the valley. Each of the five bedrooms enjoy generous proportions, natural linens and views worth waking up for. Rise early for a work out in the gym.









Outside, luxury day beds cluster around the large pool. Post-swim, head to one of the chill-out areas or the al fresco summer kitchen, barbecue and dining table decorated in the dappled shade of trees. A kick around on the small football pitch is a great way to spend cool evenings. The playhouse for the kids. Or movie night in the private cinema.

Historic San Lorenzo and the rugged northern hills are on your doorstep, as is good-life Santa Gertrudis. Great news, then, that Can Amigo comes with a Range Rover to navigate the island. Plus, a convertible Jeep for hire. Rest, reset and explore.




