
DOMUS NOVA











From the living space, slide back bi-folding windows for effortless harmony between the inside and out.






Family life continues in the spacious lower-ground kitchen, dining and living room. Pale walls, blonde floors and stone-coloured furnishings make for a thoroughly soothing interior palette. Refined, natural tones continue into the kitchen and dining areas, brightened through expansive ceiling glazing. 







A staircase with open treads channels further light into the home – a precursor to the sunny firstfloor master suite. There's understated elegance to the bedroom's pale sage walls, ivory curtains and marble fireplace, beautifully illuminated through full-height sash windows. Its ensuite is a showpiece of bathroom design: a raised tub is deftly engineered into honey-toned marble, with a large waterfall shower sitting opposite. From the stairwell of this floor, there's a second terrace overlooking peaceful Artesian Road. A serene guest bedroom, bathroom and dedicated dressing room occupies the entire second floor. A leopardprint carpeted staircase ascends to the third floor, where two further bedrooms are minimalist in design and tranquil in feel – served by a skylit family bathroom.


